Edwin H. Futa, East Honolulu, Hawai, U.S.A. His contract is till 2011.

 The official magazine of Rotary International - "The Rotarian."

Rotary News (English) and Rotary Samachar (Hindi) are the local Rotary magazines for India. It is mandatory to subscribe to any one of them.

■ The officers of any Rotary Club -

President, President Elect, Immediate Past President, Vice President/s, Treasurer and Sergantat-Arms

 The Quorum required for Annual Meeting (to be held before 31st Dec) & regular meeting of the Club -

1/3rd of the total membership.

The voting strength necessary to pass an amendment to Club Bye Laws -

2/3rd of all members present provided Quorum is present.

A member must

- (1) Attend or make up at least 50 percent of Club regular meetings in each half of the year.
- (2) Attend or make up at least 30 percent of Club's regular meetings in each half of the year.
- Club Assemblies should be held once in two months (recommended 6 in a year) and

Board of Directors - once in a month. A majority of the directors shall constitute a Quorum of the Board.
